This addendum lists temporary changes to the main Oasis Academy New Oak Behaviour for Learning Policy surrounding following return from Covid-19 to ensure children to ensuring that students settle back into school successfully and catch up rapidly.

Lever 1: Vision and Values	Staff inset days at beginning of year: focus on 'Recovery Curriculum' and supporting of students returning to school.
Lever 2: PD Curriculum	Two week whole school curriculum in September: focus on 'community and being together'. Use of text: 'Here we Are' to enable children to talk about wellbeing and return to school Diagnostic assessments and therapies to support children in addressing gaps in learning in key areas
Lever 3: Systems and structure	Proactive structures specific to covid-19 return to support most vulnerable: Family Support Link Worker and ELSA support for individuals. Well-being champions trained (children supporting others with mental health). Behaviour policy amended for rewards and sanctions- social distancing, mixing of class 'bubbles '
Lever 4: Staff development	Anna Freud training: wellbeing for staff and children Grief and Loss training plans implemented from staff training from OCL training. Mentally Healthy School training plan for the academy from OCL training.
