

Positive Recognition Boards



- A Positive Recognition Board can be found in every classroom. Every week, the teacher identifies something the class needs to work towards and writes it on the Positive Recognition Board e.g. "I will wait my turn and not shout out the answer".
- Pupils' names/photos are placed around the board and get moved to the centre when they achieve the target. The aim is to get every pupil's name/photo in the centre by the end of the day or week.
- Giving praise in this way helps our pupils precisely recognise the beneficial habits they're developing. This encourages them to repeat these behaviours in future and grow into independent and responsible adults.
- During Celebration Assembly at the end of each week, children will be praised for their efforts in completing the challenge and demonstrating exemplary behaviour.

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
