

## English

The stories we will be learning this term will be 'Billy's Bucket' and 'The Rainbow Fish'.

This term we will be teaching the children how to write stories and recounts – please encourage your child to retell stories at home.

In phonics, we will be moving on to reading and spelling longer words. You can help your child at home by asking them to spell words with at least four or five sounds in such as crunch, drench, drink.

## Maths

In Maths, the children will be looking at numbers beyond 20, adding and taking away, solving problems by counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and describing the properties of shapes.

## Creative Development

We will be creating lots of seaside art this term such as making jellyfish, pirate hats, fish window stencils and we will of course be learning our song to sing at our graduation!

## Knowledge and Understanding


