

English

We are looking at a story called 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon. The story is about a friendly creature who is lost on earth and the earth people do not seem very welcoming. Through exploring the book we will be gaining an understanding of report writing, poetry, setting descriptions, designing a good friend, in role letter writing and finally creating a guide to living on earth!

Science

This term in science we will be exploring the different seasons and investigating plant growth. We will learn the basic structure of plants and the needs a flower has to survive. We will also learn about the seasonal changes through the differences in temperature and day lengths. We will be looking closely at the similarities and differences in the seasons.

Music

This terms music will be closely linked with our science topic of seasons. Children will explore different pitches and beats in relation to different seasons.

Maths

During Maths this term will be deepening our knowledge of numbers from 50 to 100 in a range of ways. We will be applying different strategies and structures using addition and subtraction beyond 20. Finally we will be recognising the value of different coins and notes by trying to solve money related problems.

PSHE
