

English

This term we will be reading the book 'The Wolf's Footprint'. This is the story similar to Hansel and Gretel where two children get lost in the woods and go on an adventure. We will be focussing on our handwriting and spelling a lot this term.

Maths

We will be learning about properties of shape and fractions. We will be ordering fractions, finding equivalent fractions and adding fractions. We will be recognising properties of 2D and 3D shapes and angles. We will find right angles, turns and angles greater or smaller than right angles.

Humanities

We will be learning about Stonehenge. We will look at why it is a historically significant place, how it was built and use evidence to come to conclusions about it.

Science

This term we will be learning about forces and magnets. We will learn what push and pull forces, frictions and magnetism. We will learn what materials are magnetic and which are not. We will be doing lots of investigations involving magnetism and compasses.
