

English

We are reading one of my favourite books this term, *Wonder* by R.J. Palacio. The guardian said that it has the power to move hearts and can change minds and I believe it will. Whilst reading this book we will be working towards producing a factual leaflet and record our own interview after writing a script. In addition to this, we will continue to develop our reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling skills.

Science
