Dear Parents/Carers,

Arrangements for the return to school on Monday 8th March 2021

I am writing to update you on our plans for the safe reopening of the Academy for all pupils. We are looking forward to welcoming them back, and also to being able to come back together again as a whole school.

As you will know, the Government expects all pupils, unless they are classed as Clinically Extremely Vulnerable, to return to school full-time from Monday 8th March 2021.

Pupils from each Year Group will continue to be taught in their classrooms and will be in their own bubble. At playtimes and lunchtimes, children will remain in this bubble and not mix with other groups. Lunchtimes will be in classrooms, as it was at the end of last term. Keeping children in a class bubble will reduce the number of contacts each pupils has with other year groups, and reduce the chance of spreading infection.

School uniform / PE days

Pupils are expected to return in full school uniform. However, when it is their PE day, children will need to come into school dressed wearing their PE kit, as we cannot have them changing clothes in classrooms/toilets.

Drop off and Pick up Times

We still need to reduce internal travel and times, making sure we keep 2m space, reduce the number of people who we come into contact with as much as possible and try to avoid as many people on site as possible.

As before, if you have more than one child at the academy then you can drop off both children at the earliest time they are allowed in and pick up at the earliest time.

All parents/carers may now use either entrance, Walsh Avenue or Petherton Gardens and then make your way to your child's drop off point on the playground.


As soon as you have dropped off or collected your child / children, you must leave the site immediately: ensuring social distancing.
